From the President 's desk

It is always a pleasure to write a report when there is good news to convey. Vasudha team are doing such a great job for the tribal poor and needy that reporting their achievements becomes a real joy. Vasudha will be 20 years old in 2020 and already we have crossed many milestones and achieved a great deal. In 2020-2021, Vasudha was selected as one of the Ten Best NGOs to work with; we were appreciated by the UNICEF , by being one of a organizations work for the adolescent rights .In 2020-21 we have reached out to 57000 beneficiaries through our various programs. We are also aiming to be able to benefit more than 1.5 lakh beneficiaries by 2022. During our first 20 years, we have been concentrating mainly on WASH ,Health and Livelihood promotion and social well-being of the people we work with. Vasudha reached out to 10000 women from low-income families and the number of women certified through their program for Livelihood promotion, proof that stakeholder who enroll in the program understand and acknowledge the benefit vasudha brings into their lives.

Taking impetus from its previous work Vasudha this year articulated and highlighted issues of adolescent rights and Anemia & Nutrition at the National and international level as well. Vasudha was able to present its experience of working with local policing systems vis-à-vis adolescent . We worked on sensitization and working with local governments and adolescent led to greater impact.

All these activities made it possible for Vasudha to highlight a few issues at the national level. Issues of Adolescent rights in tribal areas have now been taken up for action by UNICEF and Government respectively.

CAPABILITY STATEMENT

VasudhaVikasSansthan is a National level Non-Government Voluntary Organization operating since 2000 and registered as a Society with the Registrar of Firms & Societies, Madhya Pradesh, Bhopal,. We have the exemption under Section 80-G and 12-A of the Income Tax Act. We are also registered under the Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Act (FCRA).

The society has been founded & it is being run by group of professionals with a multidisciplinary background and considerable grass root experiences. Experts realize that natural resources like land, water and forest, which are the assets for providing livelihood, have turned into liabilities due to its over exploitation and neglect and vasudha is trying to focus in this gray area to help up-liftment of Women and Children.

Organization is having experience of more than 20 years in conceptualizing, executing and managing development projects and programs in Health, Menstrual Hygiene Management (MHM), Hygiene Promotion, Behavior Change Communication (BCC), Wise Water Management, Water Quality, Total Sanitation (TS) and Fluoride Mitigation. Professional working in the organization has the expertise on handholding, training, Module development, project appraisal, evaluation, resource planning, deployment, project estimation, scheduling, tracking and implementation, and output focused research. Participatory approaches and techniques; coupled with advice, advocacy and support to women and children facing personal and social problems. We employ effective communicating skills, excellent inter-personal relation management and networking skills to make successful ventures with community and donor agencies.

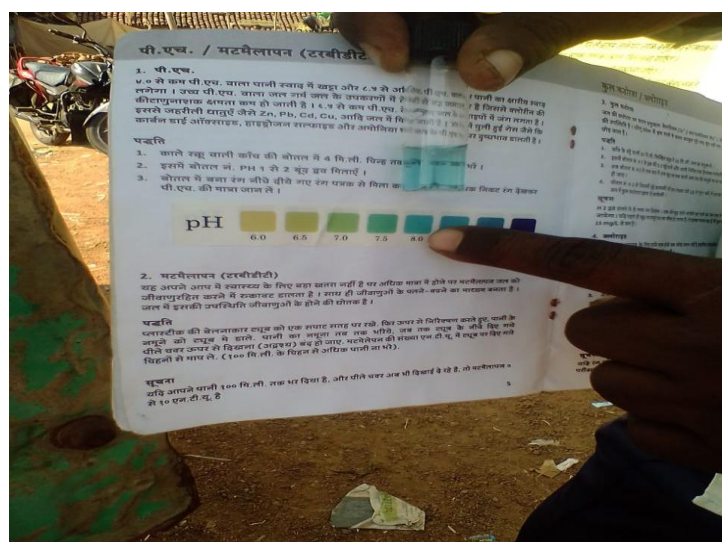

HEALTH SECTOR

- We trained 1340 ASHA Worker, on ASHA Module 6-7 Training. Training of health worker about main national diseases, MMR&IMR reduction, cent percent immunization of child and pregnant women, emergency health facilities in remote villages, we trained about examination, registration and documentation With Support from National Health Mission MP.
- Under Adolescent health program we undertake the development of Poshan Waticas in Jhabua district of M.P with 50 Adolescent Girls . Training of Adolescent Girls and Women's under this Program with support from UNICEF and Govt of MP.
- Awareness creation and Training with more than 30 self Help Groups on issue of Menstrual Hygiene Management CASA Supported program.
- Implemented Rashtriya Kishore Swasthya Karyakram (RKSK) with support from National Health Mission in District Umria
- Develop adolescent groups on self defense with Support from Center for Catalyzing Change (C3)
